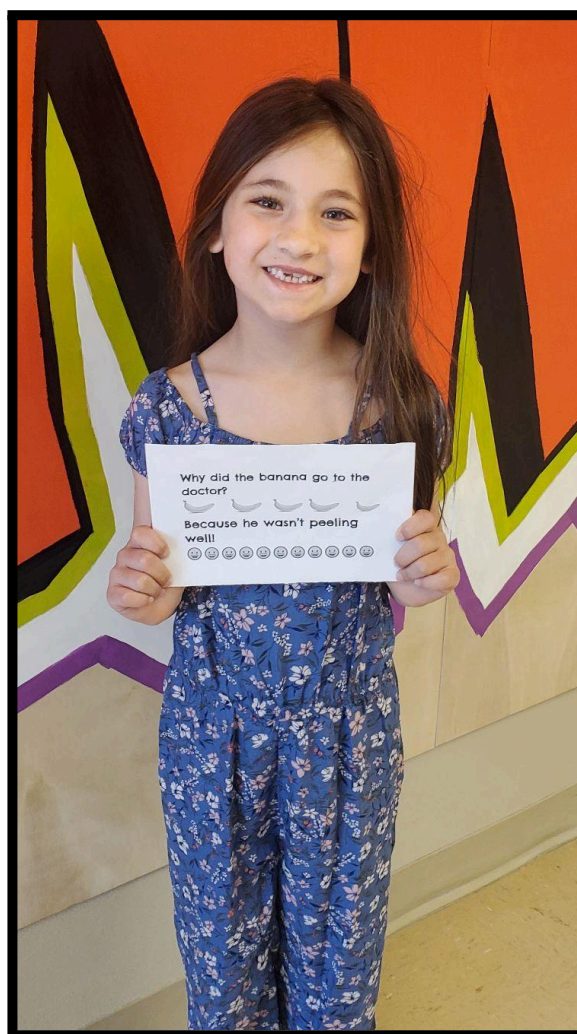
Henning Super Star Students!

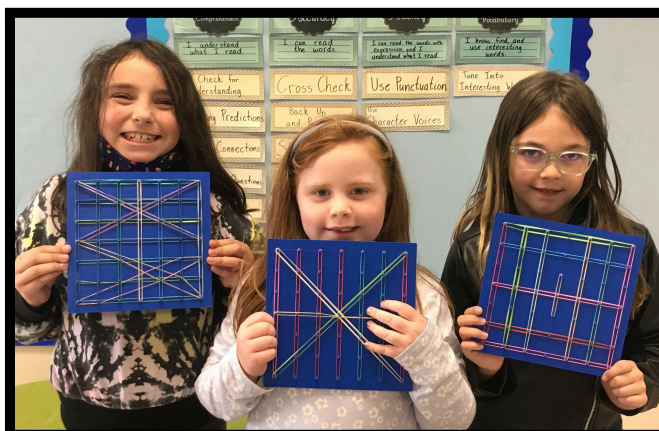
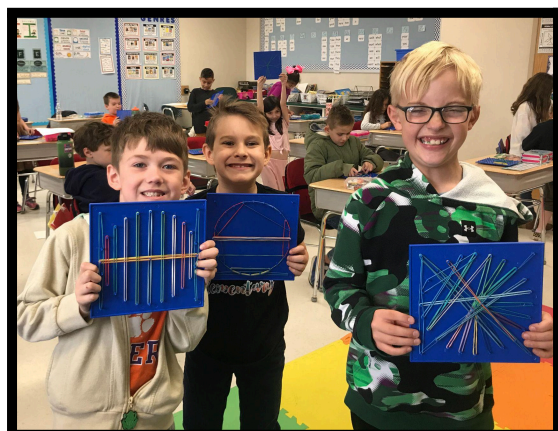


Henning Wishlist!
