Houses into Homes: Washington Freeman Peck Award

The Iowa Medical Society presented the 2025 Washington Freeman Peck Award to *Houses into Homes*, a nonprofit organization based in Iowa City that works to ensure every child and family has a safe, comfortable home. The organization provides gently used beds, furniture, and household items to families and individuals exiting homelessness or domestic violence situations. The Peck Award annually honors lay organizations for outstanding contributions to the health and wellbeing of Iowans, and *Houses into Homes* demonstrates this spirit through its deep commitment to dignity and stability for all.

Kari Harland, PhD, MPH: John F. Sanford Award

IMS awarded the 2025 John F. Sanford award to *Kari Harland, PhD, MPH*, in recognition of her sustained dedication to improving public health through research, education, and advocacy. Dr. Harland is an epidemiologist and assistant professor at the University of Iowa Carver College of Medicine, where her work spans injury prevention, maternal and child health, and disparities in care. The Sanford Award honors lay individuals whose contributions to health care or public health have had lasting impact in Iowa and beyond.

Rob Lee, MD: Merit Award

Rob Lee, MD, received the 2025 IMS Merit Award—one of the highest honors presented by the society. Dr. Lee is widely respected for his clinical excellence, leadership within IMS, and dedicated support of Iowa physicians. He has served in numerous IMS roles, including on the Board of Directors and as a trusted voice in statewide policy discussions. The Merit Award recognizes a physician's extraordinary contributions to the medical profession and to the mission of IMS.
