

## 2023 AHEAD in Virginia Disability Student Scholarship Information

AHEAD in Virginia is pleased you are interested in this scholarship opportunity!. We had a very successful application process for 2022 and hope to continue to have high interest at member institutions across the state this year!

- PLEASE READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY for instructions and information. The majority of students found not eligible for the scholarship last year did not follow instructions and had incomplete applications.
- All required student information submitted at one time with the application, including the transcript and personal statement.
- Institutional verification is completed by any institutional employee recommended by the student.
- Institutional membership is confirmed by the Scholarship Committee Chair.
- Student applicants will receive confirmation of receipt of application.

## **General Information and Eligibility**

**A. Purpose:** The AHEAD in Virginia Scholarship is provided to acknowledge and support students with disabilities who are striving to earn a degree, overcoming challenges and serving their community.

## B. Eligibility:

- a. Enrolled in an accredited Virginia Institution of Higher Education at the time of application
- b. Must have a High School Diploma or GED
- c. Dual-enrolled/high school students are not eligible
- d. Enrolled in a Certificate/Associate, Undergraduate or Graduate degree-seeking program of study
- e. Enrolled in at least three (3) credit hours for both Fall and Spring of the competition year
- f. Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- g. The student must be formally registered with their college or university disability office. The student is not required to be actively using services during the semester of application for scholarship.
- h. The institution where the student is enrolled must have at least one current member of AHEAD in Virginia for the competition year.
- Students may apply on an annual basis for the category (degree program) in which they are enrolled for that academic year: associate degree or less, undergraduate degree, or graduate degree program.
- C. Criteria for Award: The Selection Committee will consider the following criteria:
  - a. Personal statement (all specific information needed is included in the Checksheet linked below)
    - i. Formatting
    - ii. Answers to questions are compelling and thorough, demonstrating disability awareness, leadership and community service.



- iii. Readability correct grammar, spelling and punctuation.
- b. Verification:
  - i. Verification the student is registered with the disability services office
  - ii. Statement of support provided by the individual completing the Institutional Verification form.
- D. Submission Deadlines: The <u>applicant</u> is responsible for ensuring:
  - a. Application is due for submission no later than **March 20, 2023, 5:00 p.m.** Institutional Verification form due for submission no later than **March 29, 2023, 5:00 p.m**
- **E. Notification:** Scholarship applicants will be notified of their award status on or before **April 21, 2023.** We anticipate awarding the following to students with disabilities attending a Virginia institution:
  - a. One (1) \$1000 scholarship to a student enrolled in a program leading to an Associate's Degree or less at any 2-year, community, or technical/vocational college in Virginia.
  - b. One (1) \$1000 scholarship to an <u>undergraduate student</u> enrolled in a program leading to a Bachelor's Degree at a <u>private</u> college or university in Virginia.
  - c. One (1) \$1000 scholarship to an <u>undergraduate student</u> enrolled in a program leading to a Bachelor's Degree at a <u>public</u> college or university in Virginia.
  - d. One (1) \$1000 scholarship to a graduate student enrolled at any college or university in Virginia.
