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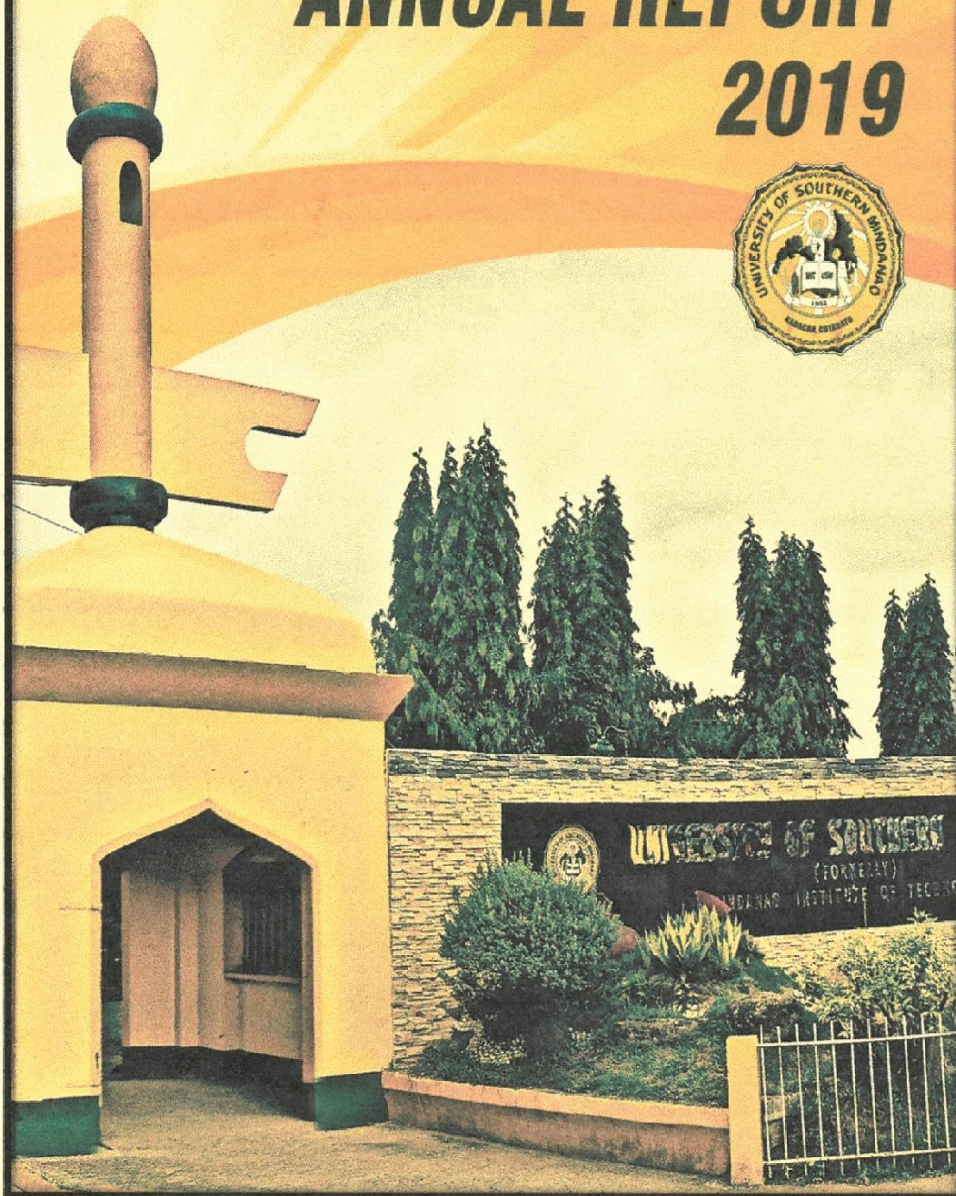

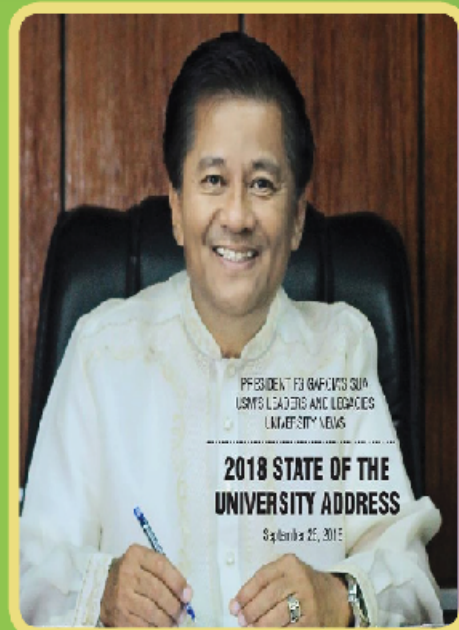

Institute of Middle East and Asian Studies (IMEAS)

The Institute of Middle East and Asian Studies (IMEAS) was established by virtue of BOR Resolution No. 20 series of 1993. It initially offered courses leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science in Islamic Studies (BSIS) with technologically educational specialization. In June 1988, the Institute was in full operation with four (4) faculty members and two (2) staff and 32 freshmen students.

INSTRUCTION

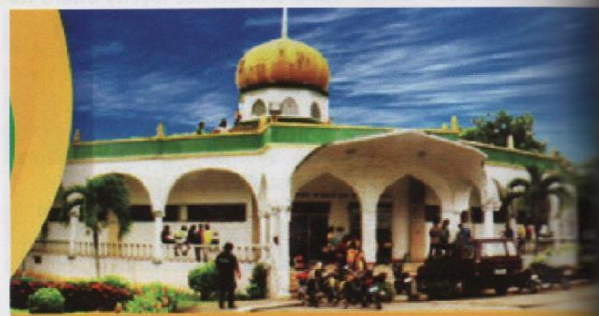
- Registered 938 students enrolled on the first sem of SY 2018-2019.
- Freshmen and higher year students availed free education privileges except for requested subjects.
- One hundred fifty (150) students availed financial assistance
- Both programs (BAIS and BSIR) were Level-1 accredited and confirmed by AACUP BOT and NNQAA.
- Curriculum revision was approved by CHED RO12 for implementation effective first sem SY 2018-2019.
- Fifteen (15) syllabi in BAIS and 15 syllabi in BSIR were revised.
- Eight (8) instructional materials were developed.
- Conducted regular faculty and staff meeting twice a semester

RESEARCH

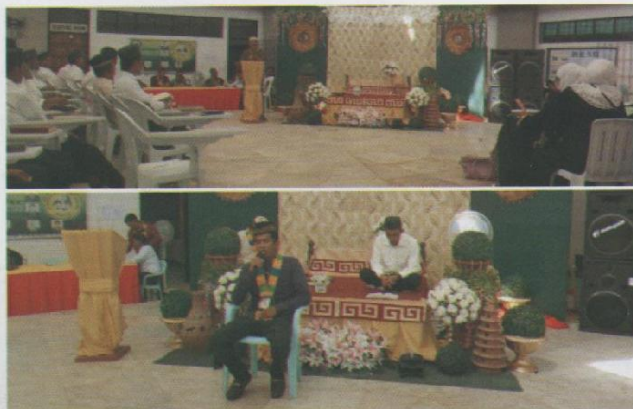
- One (1) submitted research funded under GAD funds worth P 80,000.00.

Other Accomplishments:

- One faculty graduated MPA on June 2018, and another faculty completed MAIS and returned to duty.
- The renovation of the IMEAS building started on the 1st semester of the academic year 2018-2019 with a budget of 2.8 million pesos. It is expected to be finished on or before the second semester of the academic year 2019-2020. The renovation has three components: (1) painting, (2) division of offices and classrooms and (3) wiring.
- Spearheaded the 1st Cotabato Provincial Qur'an Reading Competition which was held at the Institute of Middle East and Asian Studies on January 27, 2018 and this was participated by 42 contestants from the different Municipalities of Cotabato Province.
- Some faculty and students attended the Public Congressional Hearing conducted at the Municipal Gymnasium of Midsayap, Cotabato on February 16, 2018. The hearing focused on the Proposed Bangsamoro Basic Law (BBL).



- MagPeace Scholars participated in the Inaul festival held at the Municipality of Buluan, Maguindanao on February 8-14, 2018. INNAUL is a symbol of Unity, Love and solidarity among the constituents of Maguindanao Province. Participation of MagPeace Scholars in this festival is a gesture of their gratitude to the Province of Maguindanao Leadership, from Hon. Governor Esmail "TOTO" Mangudadato in granting scholarships to the USM students. According to Sir Abdu "GONIE" A. Yusop, a MagPeace Scholarship Coordinator, number of students successfully graduated through the assistance of Province of Maguindanao in the MagPeace. MagPeace stands for Maguindanao Program on Educational Assistance and Community Empowerment.
