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Main Airports in Poland:

There are 12 civil airports in Poland. The main airport is **Okecie airport** (*Frederic Chopin airport in Warsaw*) - the Warsaw airport dominates, serving more than half of passengers flying to and from Poland. The remaining 11 airports are referred to as regional, which used to be auxiliary airports for Okecie. Currently, these ports are growing and offer foreign flights themselves.

There are some ways to get from **Warsaw Chopin Airport/Warsaw Modlin Airport** to **Łódź**:

-by train : Check the tickets on the website PKP.pl. On this site you can select the departure date and the desired time. Most often, on the way from the airport to Lodz, it will be necessary to make a stopover at another railway station in Warsaw. All information will be indicated in your ticket. If necessary, contact the railway station workers for help. The ticket price is from 30-40 PLN (about 6,5- 9 EUR).

-by bus: Bus tickets should be bought earlier or at the ticket office at the station in Warsaw. In order to get to Lodz by bus, you need to get to the bus station in Warsaw (Mostly **Warsaw West Station/ Warszawa Zachodnia** and less often **Warsaw Central Station/ Warszawa Centralna**) from where buses go to Lodz. **Don't forget to buy a public transport ticket.** (20-minute ticket=2,2PLN/0.5EUR, 75-minute ticket=4,4 PLN/1 EUR)

From Warsaw Chopin Airport to Warsaw Central Station/Warsaw West Station: Bus: line №175 (Center), N32 (Center.Night bus). Train: S2, S3, RL. Taxi: from 40 PLN/9 EUR)

From Warsaw Modlin Airport to Warsaw Central Station/Warsaw West Station: Bus: ModlinBus to the city center (price about 10 PLN/2,2 EUR). Train: KM, IC. Taxi: from 100PLN/22 EUR.

From all another cities you can reach Lodz by plane, train or bus. The most convenient solution would be to travel by train. You can check tickets and prices on the website PKP.pl. And on this site E-podroznik.pl you can find tickets on buses and trains to Lodz from every city. **Have a nice journey!**

Main railway and bus stations in Lodz (Łódź)

Łódź Fabryczna - the main railway station in Łódź. It was established on the initiative of the industrialist Karol Scheibler in 1866. Currently, the complex combines railway, bus (city and long-distance), tram, bicycle and car transport. The station is located in the **city center**, about 500 meters from **Piotrkowska Street**. The **Central Bus Station** is nearby. Access to the city center:

- by trams: *lines №7, 9, 12, 13.*

- by bus: *line №57.*

For people traveling without heavy luggage, we recommend a 15-minute walk to **Piotrkowska Street**.

Łódź Kaliska - the second largest railway station in Łódź, located on the west of the city center (about 2 km from the Piotrkowska Street). On the eastern side there is the **Łódź-Kaliska PKS Station**, from which most of long-distance buses and local buses depart to the south-west. Access to the city center:

- by tram: *lines №8, 10, 12, 14.*

- by bus: *lines №80, 86, 98, 99, L (airport)*

National currency

The national currency in Poland is **Polish Zloty**. You can pay by card (you should consider the commission of your bank), withdraw cash from an ATM/**bankomat** (also consider the commission), or exchange your currency in an exchanger/**kantor**. The approximate exchange rate at the moment is:

1 euro ≈ 4,72 złoty

Public transport in Lodz (Łódź)

Traveling by public transport is the cheapest and the most ecological way to travel around the city. You can move around Lodz by **tram** or by **bus**. **Do not forget to buy tickets!**

Where can you buy tickets?

-In stationary ticket machines/**biletomat** (*By cash or card*)

-At ticket sales points (MPK) (*By cash or card*)

-In transport ticket machines/**biletomat in transport** (*Only card*)

In Poland, the ticket is bought depending on the time of the trip, therefore: a **20-minute ticket** costs 4,40PLN/0,93EUR,

a **40-minute ticket** 5.60PLN/1,19EUR. A **daily ticket**

(for 24 hours) costs 18PLN/3,82EUR, the same price is for a **weekend ticket**

(from Friday evening to Monday morning). A **ticket for 5 days** around the city costs

36PLN/8EUR. There is also a **tourist ticket** for 10PLN/2.2 EUR. These prices are for

and around +3/4 °C by night

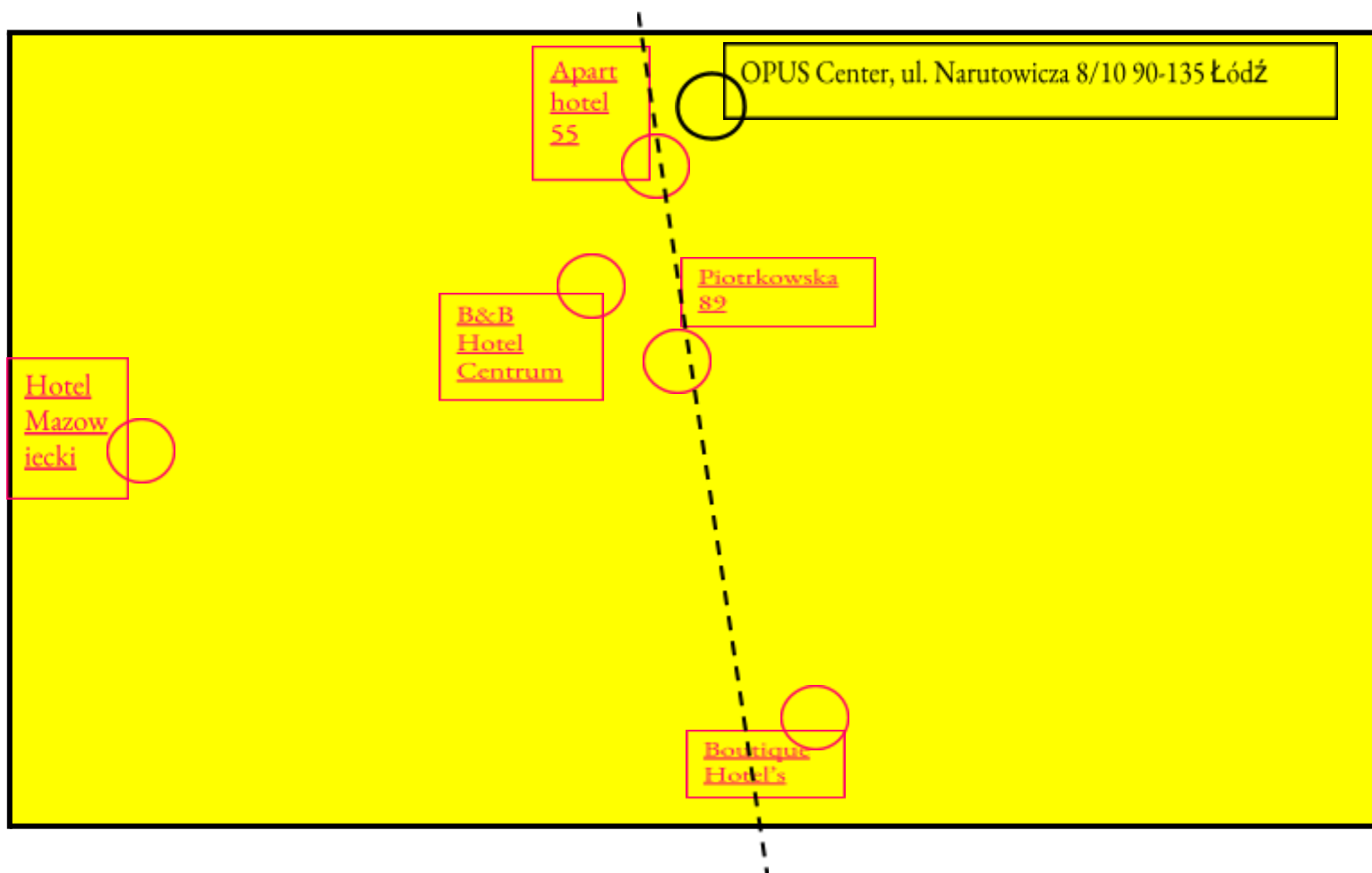
Bear in mind that weather in Poland can be tricky so it's better to prepare for colder days just in case of additional rain or even snowing.

Here are proposed hostels/hotels in the center or close to the center:



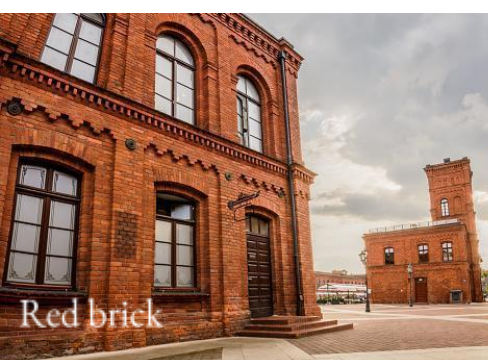
