Thy kingdom come, Thy will be
done in earth, as it is in heaven.

NASB

‘Our Father, who is in heaven,
Hallowed be Your name.

Your kingdom come.

Your will be done,
On earth as it is in heaven.

3 What do these verses teach us?

Ezekiel 36:22

"Therefore, say to the Israelites, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: It is not for your sake, people of Israel, that I am going to do these things, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations where you have gone.'"

Isaiah 43:7

"Everyone who is called by my name, whom I created for my glory, whom I formed and made."

Isaiah 48:

for the sake of my praise I hold it back from you,
so as not to destroy you completely.
See, I have refined you, though not as silver;
I have tested you in the furnace of affliction.
