Arrival by Car

The best address to use for the following navigation systems has been provided.

Google & Apple Maps: McMahon Hall

You will arrive via the entrance to the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, then continue past the basilica and take a right hand turn into the McMahon Hall parking lot. If you are being dropped off and will not need to park, the preferred drop off location is seen on the dotted line on the map, just have your driver take a right hand turn from the basilica parking lot to university drive and the McMahon circle.

The Office of Global strategies is located in McMahon 109, which is at the end of the Eastern wing of the first floor.

For suitable parking, please follow the directions as provided by the map below to a purple lot. All vehicles parked at The Catholic University of America are required to register for a valid parking permit. Visitors can register for temporary parking permits via myparking.catholic.edu. All visitor permits are based on license plate number, so you will not be required to display anything in your vehicle.



Arrival by Metro

Catholic University has its own metro stop, called Brookland-CUA on the red line.

Once exiting the metro, cross the crosswalk towards the Catholic University sign. During the construction of the Conway School of Nursing, guests are asked to walk around the Crough School of Architecture to reach the western side of campus. The map below shows these two routes.
