Clearances For Volunteers

According to current Child Protective Services Laws, anyone who volunteers in a school is required to show proof of clearances before interacting with children. Below you will find information on how to obtain these clearances for free (if you have been a PA Resident for the past 10 years).

In order to spend time in our classrooms, every volunteer must bring copies of the following three documents at the time of the interaction. The copies will be kept on file (please do not bring originals).

1. State Police Criminal History Clearance
2. Child Abuse Clearance
3. Written Affirmation Form for those who have been a resident of PA for the past ten years

-OR-

FBI Fingerprinting Clearance for those who have not been a resident of PA for ten years

All documents must have been obtained within the last five years. Follow the directions below to request current clearances.

Act 34 PA State Police Clearance

This clearance is **free for volunteers**. Click on the “New Record Check - Volunteers Only” button and then follow the directions on the screen.

Act 151 PA Child Abuse Clearance

This clearance is **free for volunteers**. Click on the “Create Individual Account” button and then follow the directions on the screen.

Act 114 FBI Fingerprinting Clearance

I have been a PA resident for the past 10 years	If a volunteer has been a Pennsylvania resident for ten years prior to the application, and swears by written affirmation that he/she is not disqualified due to a conviction for any crime listed in the CPSL, the FBI Fingerprinting Clearance is not required. Please sign and return the Affirmation Form that is attached to this letter along with copies of your State Police Clearance and Child Abuse Clearance.

After you register and pay the fee on line you will receive a registration number that you must take with you along with photo id to a fingerprinting site. - Section 2702 (relating to aggravated assault)
- Section 2709.1 (relating to stalking)
- Section 2901 (relating to kidnapping)
- Section 2902 (relating to unlawful restraint)
- Section 3121 (relating to rape)

- Section 3123 (relating to involuntary deviate sexual intercourse)
- Section 3124.1 (relating to sexual assault)
- Section 3125 (relating to aggravated indecent assault)
- Section 3126 (relating to indecent assault)
- Section 3127 (relating to indecent exposure)
- Section 4302 (relating to incest)
- Section 4303 (relating to concealing death of child)
- Section 4304 (relating to endangering welfare of children)
- Section 4305 (relating to dealing in infant children)
- A felony offense under section 5902(b) (relating to prostitution and related offenses)
- Section 5903(c) or (d) (relating to obscene and other sexual materials and performances)
- Section 6301 (relating to corruption of minors)
- Section 6312 (relating to sexual abuse of children)
- A felony offense under the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L. 233, No. 64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, committed within the five-year period immediately preceding today's date
- The attempt, solicitation or conspiracy to commit any of the above offenses

I hereby affirm that the information contained in this volunteer affirmation is correct. I further affirm that in the event that I am arrested for or convicted of an offense that would constitute grounds for denying my further participation as a school volunteer, or if I am accused as a perpetrator of child abuse, I will provide the SRU/SGA Preschool and Child Care Center with written notice no later than 72 hours after the arrest, conviction or notification that I have been listed as a perpetrator of child abuse in the statewide database.
