GREETINGS FROM THE NYS WOODSMEN'S CORPORATION...

WE ARE BACK IN BUSINESS!!! The 78th annual New York State Woodsmen's Field Days will be held RAIN OR SHINE -- on August 15-17, 2025. *We invite you* to attend the Field Days which will be held at the Boonville-Oneida County Fairgrounds in Boonville, NY. The campground is located across the street from the main event site.

Each camper will have a 1,500 sq. foot camping area. This area must be maintained throughout your visit. All camping equipment must stay within your area and a 10' space must be maintained between camping units. Please be advised that camping pre-registration through the mail is limited and on a first-received-first-served basis. Once camping pre-registration reaches its capacity, camping will be closed to outside reservations. As a result, **PLEASE FORWARD YOUR INFORMATION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.** Camping staff will direct you to your site upon your PRE-REGISTERED arrival check-in date.

THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO ELECTRIC PRE-REGISTRATION AVAILABLE. *However, upon your arrival of your pre-registered check-in date, there is a possibility of limited electric site upgrades being available on a first-come, first-served basis. An additional fee of \$5 per night will be charged at the time of your upgrade IF IT IS AVAILABLE. Generators are permitted to run. Portable restroom facilities are available as well as hand washing areas. A limited number of shower rooms will be available across the street on the main event site. There is a brand new shower and restroom facility that has been updated and remodeled -- just behind the grandstand.*

The NYS Woodsmen's Field Days is a three day paid gate event with FREE limited seating and free grandstand events to be held all morning and afternoon throughout the weekend. The grounds will be filled with forest industry exhibitors displaying the latest in tools, technology and equipment in the forest industry.

As per the board of directors of the NYS Woodsmen's Field Days, Inc., absolutely no live bands will be permitted on the fairgrounds. Campers will not be permitted to hire and/or host their own musical entertainment.

Credit cards are accepted for camping registration passes and tickets. A separate form is in your packet if you would like to take advantage of this service.

According to Oneida County Health Department regulations, the following must be abided by:

1. EACH AND EVERY CAMPER WILL HAVE SPECIFIC LIMITS TO THE AMOUNT OF SPACE BETWEEN EACH UNIT. THIS SPACE MUST BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND.
2. THERE WILL BE NO GRAY WATER DUMPING PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS. Gray water can be dumped into individual covered containers, which must be brought by each camper.
3. IF YOU ARE FORTUNATE ENOUGH TO BUY A SITE UPGRADE TO ELECTRIC – PLEASE REMEMBER THAT NO 'HOME STYLE' EXTENSION CORDS ARE PERMITTED. Only heavy-duty, industrial strength cords will be permitted.

It is important that all campers comply with all health department regulations to the best of their ability.

Regarding pets, we respectfully request that all pet owners properly restrain their pet throughout their stay at the Field Days and clean-up after them. **Absolutely no pets are allowed in the exhibit and/or seating and grandstand areas.**

For your safety, bicycles may only be ridden within the **campground area** after 6 pm. No bicycles can be ridden in the exhibit/camping area between the hours of 8 AM and 6 PM throughout the three days. **HELMETS ARE A MUST.**

WE REMIND YOU that it is illegal to have open containers of alcoholic beverages at any time on any street in the village of Boonville, and we are requesting that all attendees comply with this ordinance. We would like to take this opportunity to remind all campers that no alcoholic beverages are permitted in or around the exhibit areas on the fairgrounds.

ABSOLUTELY NO SITES WILL BE SAVED OR SPOTTED IN 2022. THE WOODSMEN'S CORPORATION WILL NOT PERMIT CAMPERS TO SAVE SPECIFIC CAMPSITES. THERE IS NO EARLY PARKING OR "SPOTTING" OF THE CAMPER UNITS. ALL CAMPERS MUST ARRIVE ON THE DAY THAT YOUR PERMIT HAS BEEN PURCHASED.

Your tickets and passes will be mailed to you in mid-July.
