Join a Zoom meeting

You don't need a Zoom account or to have downloaded Zoom in order to watch and participate in our panels and activities.

Download Zoom

You'll need to download the Zoom client for your computer or mobile device to join a meeting. Generally, you'll be prompted to install Zoom when you click a meeting invite link. You can also download it ahead of time.

Change your display name

If you're using an existing Zoom account, we recommend changing your display name in your user settings before joining a CON.TXT meeting.

1. Visit zoom.us
2. Log in to your account.
3. Click on **My Account**.

4. On the **Profile** page, click **Edit** to the right of your name.
