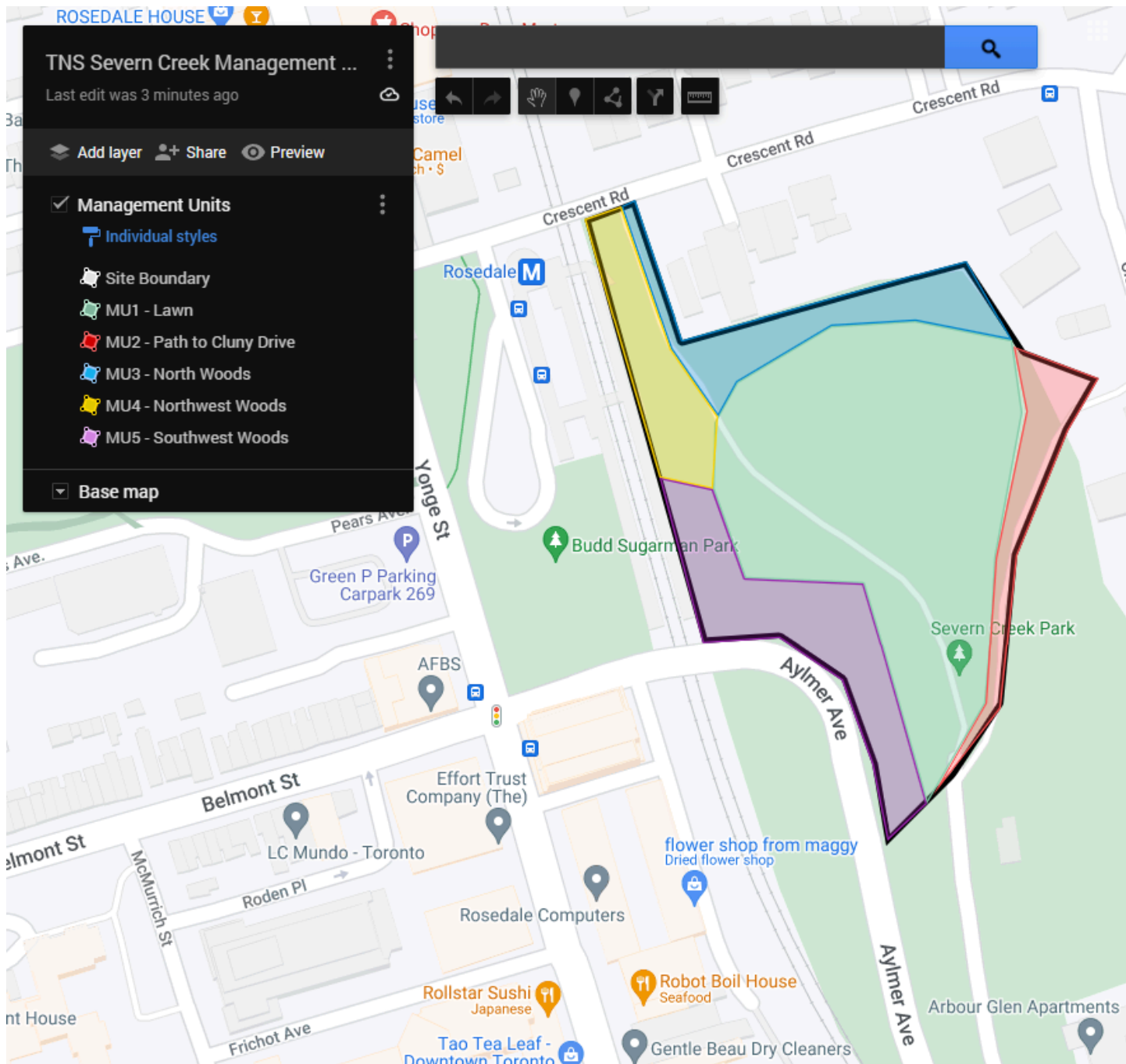

Severn Creek Park is located close to downtown, just north of Bloor & Yonge and right next to Rosedale TTC Station. It's right between Ramsden Park and the green corridor bordering Rosedale Valley Road, and is a small park with two main trails and a central mown lawn area. The park is surrounded by steep upward slopes in almost all directions, and there are no bodies of water anywhere in the park.

The trail that runs to the northwest ends in a series of steep, uneven concrete steps and exits the park next to the entrance to Rosedale Station. The trail running northeast to Cluny Drive is sloping, covered in gravel, and bordered by large stone blocks. To the south, there's a small parking lot and car access through Rosedale Valley Road and a Toronto Forestry building on the southern edge of the park. There are no washrooms or water fountains onsite.
