**AT Website (unpublished)**: using Google sites you can make your own website. Resources for AAC, AT and contact information for AT consultants at MARESA.

Peer to Peer: meeting in small groups with Zoom or Google Hangout Tips for Hard of Hearing/Deaf students: using closed captions, Google has features that will enable closed captions such as Google Slides will do Live captioning

Zoom Tips and tricks: waiting room to filter who is allowed in to the meeting. Set a doorbell to alert that people are waiting. Make sure that you are the last one to leave the meeting so students cannot continue to meet; Poll feature will be explored at a later time.

## How to set up polling for zoom

<u>Bookshare</u>: A site that helps students with qualifying <u>reading disabilities</u> (low vision, physical disabilities or reading disabilities) with a documented reading disability. Each organization should have a district contact who then adds the sponsors. A sponsor will add the student to the Bookshare and can set up reading lists to assign books to students. Students can access textbooks, classroom books as well as personal reading. Reading can be customized to watch the text with highlighting and listen to the audio and other options.

Google doc voice typing: speech to text within a Google doc. Read and Write for Google: Text to speech to read screen
