Interim: Administrative Guidelines

A. Operational Guidelines for Assessments

Some of the guidelines for test administration are listed below:

Teachers will prepare testing sites in accordance with health and safety guidelines and directives. They will also prepare the necessary testing materials and equipment (i.e. laptop, writing tools, scratch papers, etcetera) prior to the testing event.

B. Before Testing: Preparing Accommodations

The unit assessments are part of classroom instruction. As such, classroom accommodations should be provided to students who have accommodations in their program plans (ESOL, IEP, and 504). Teachers must plan and prepare to provide the accommodations, accessibility features, and administrative considerations as they would normally during instruction.

C. Before Testing: Test Assignment for Digital versions

Teachers must follow all guidelines in the Test Administration Guidance from DoDEA.

D. After Testing: Scoring Guideline

Teachers will access and analyze students' results using the Pearson Digital Platform and the provided protocols. ISSs and instructional coaches will support teacher teams to identify misconceptions and areas of need in order to support tiered instruction
