### Circulation

As you will see from the included Polaris report, our circulation for July was 14,421. Our circulation for last July was 13,905.

### Inter-Library Loan

In July, we received 118 books and other items to fill requests made by our patrons. We also sent out 322 items to other libraries for their patrons. Those reports are included with the package.

### New Patrons

Sarah and I had a busy month with registering new patron. We now have 30 new users.

### Collection Development

In July, we added 68 adult books, 2 young adult books, 10 children's books, 6 DVD's, and 9 magazines. We discarded 17 adult books, 3 young adult books, and 6 children's books. At this moment, we have three books on order.
