Activity/Outline: Over the week students are expected to read the stories <u>How the Camel Got His Hump</u> and <u>Where Do Dreams Come From</u> then answer the questions that go along with them. Remember I expect 5 sentences for a paragraph. Please remember to use your capitals and punctuation marks as well.

All students should be reading daily. I suggest finding or starting a family book. Find a time every day or night that is your "reading time". The goal is to read outloud and read a book together. Children are more likely to finish a story if they read it together with someone. Take turns reading aloud. This can be different times and places for many. Some prefer to have this time right before bed. You can do it while cooking dinner. If you have a drive home everyday it is a great time for your child to read to you...not so much for you to read to them if you are driving:) You get the idea, establish that time everyday and before you know it you will be looking forward to what is happening in the book.
