Pathway to Real World Applications 2

Point of View: What is the discipline or area/sub-area of study? What do I already know that will help me understand this text?	
Purpose: What is my purpose for reading the text?	
Question at Hand: What is the argument, problem, issue or topic discussed?	
Information -data points, theories and experiences, terms (What new concepts are critical for understanding?)	

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What questions do I have?	
Implications: if this text is true, what does it mean? for the area of study? for the world? for me?	
Applications: How are these ideas tested? (Identify a real-world situation where these ideas are applicable. How does it inform how you will act in real-world situations?)
