
Personality and Appearance.

<u>TERPSICHORE</u> - Terpsichore is a gentle ancient well versed in the art of creating song as well as a skilled dancer, and a student of the Words of Altima, the convocation member advocating the arts. <u>ORPHEUS</u> - A good friend of Asklepios, and the creator of the infamous morbol, Orpheus possesses an intense love for all manner of concepts that others may find odd or unsightly. Her and Asklepios met when he first discovered her beloved morbol concept, and in a desperate bid to find who gave form to such a magnificent creature he set off in search of its creator. Orpheus and Asklepios love to spend their free time annoying, bothering, aggravating, and inconveniencing Emet-Selch in whatever ways they can, often recruiting Hythlodaeus into their schemes too.



<u>HYTHLODAEUS</u> - Asklepios would come to meet Hythlodaeus during visits to the Bureau of the Architect to submit his concepts. The two would strike up conversation and quickly became friends. Asklepios and Hyth greatly enjoy teasing Emet-Selch together along with their friend Orpheus. During the final days, Asklepios begged Hythlodaeus not to surrender his soul to summon Zodiark.
