Tollway Limitation Bill 2021

OUTLINE

The Tollway Limitation Bill 2021 establishes a ceiling on the percentage of Tollways in our key roads. This is to prevent total private ownership or fees on all of our roads of key national significance. A growing number of key roads in Australia's metropolitan areas are requiring fees for use. These fees are becoming a growing part of working families expenditures, further driving up the cost of living in our major cities.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There will be no financial impact on the federal budget of Australia, provided Tollways do not exceed the limit specified in the act
