Please continue to fervently lift up those who were impacted by this week's tragic events - especially the first responders and others who remain hospitalized and are still recovering. We stand with them. We pray for them. We honor them.

There may be media present. I have asked them simply to attend, and I will provide a statement in the coming days. Today, let's keep our focus where it belongs - on worship, unity, and gratitude.
