Entry:

\$5 per person must be paid through venmo to @makenzie-schlegel-1. If you don't have venmo please give cash to Makenzie Schlegel (919)527-5579 or Jacob Wilder (919)594-4187 in a bag with your name on it. Money will be held until the end of the game and given to the winner. There will also be a cash prize for the person with the most kills.

What is This?

The game is a water gun game in which everyone is assigned a person to "kill" by spraying them with a water gun in public. If you are sprayed/hit then you're out of the game and cannot get back in. **The game is NOT allowed to be played on school grounds/campus.**

How it Works:

The game maker (ZZ) will text you or DM you through the instagram account your assignment. Once you have killed your assignment for the round, you must take a picture to document your kill. **FOR COVID REASONS PLEASE MAINTAIN A SOCIAL DISTANCE IN YOUR PICTURES, YOU CAN DO ELBOW TAPS OR A SOCIALLY DISTANCED HANDSHAKE.** Try to get a video of the kill for the instagram and text ZZ (919)527-5579 or dm lrhs.senior.assassin. You can also send in failed attempts. If you are eliminated please be cool about it, no one likes a sore loser. Once you have killed your assignment you immediately take that person's assignment. After you send us your video of the kill we will send you that person's assignment. ***If you use anything other than a water gun with water in it you will be disqualified*.** No switching targets. Once you get your target out, you're safe until the next week or round, unless the person who has you gets out. **Any kills you make that are not your assigned target will not count.** Sundays are off days that allow the coordinators to assign your new target.

Weapons:

ALL WATER GUNS ARE ALLOWED. Water balloons are also allowed but must be a direct hit. Try to get a video of all kills. If something other than water is used the kill will not count. No water hoses. SHIELDS ARE PERMITTED. Rain jackets, ponchos, trash

bags, etc. do not count. If your clothes get wet you are out. If you have questions about your water gun ask the coordinators.

Off-limit Zones:

This is not a school related activity. Please do not bring this game to school. You're responsible for your own actions

Absolutely no assassinations on school property or during any school event. No kills during the school day on campus. Parking lots are fair game. Places that are off limits include sports practices, games, and performances held at any school. As soon as you leave school property in the afternoon it's fair game.

No assassinations inside your target's workplace. Your target becomes safe the moment they walk into their workplace. Parking lots are fair game before or after work.

No assassinations in churches or places of worship. Parking lots are fair game.

No assassinations in your target's home. Their yard, driveway, street, or sheds are fair game.

Once they step into their home or garage they are safe and cannot be shot. If their garage is open and they are inside of it you still cannot shoot them. If their window is open and they're inside you still cannot shoot them.

Shooting your target in their car, when it is at rest, is fair game.

Drive by shots do count as long as the assassin is not the driver. Please be safe.

Rule breaking behavior is reported to us.

Assassinations:

If you were killed and try to avoid it, you will be marked as killed anyways. Please be honest and accept the loss. Do not try and argue that you weren't killed even when you were.

You must kill your target to move on to the next round and get a new target. Any kills that are not your assigned targets will not count.

*****WARNING*****

By paying to be in the game and having your name officially listed as a player, you are agreeing to play by the rules listed and have spoken to one of the coordinators. Going against any of the rules will lead to disqualification from the game. The coordinators are just the organizers of the game and do not take responsibility for the actions performed by the participants. Any activity that goes against the stated rules and regulations stated will not be the responsibility of the coordinators or Leesville Road High School. We are not responsible for any misconduct. LRHS is not associated with senior assassin. Being caught with weapons on school grounds or being caught accessing this site at school is the sole responsibility of the participant, not the coordinator.
