League Rules:

- Use drop zones to help pace of play
- Play OB and weeds as lateral hazard
- Double par pickup, no putting out
 - Ex: par3 = double par is 6 (no adding or circling)
 - Sand Traps: decide as a group if they are in bad shape to drop nearest point of relief inside the trap or outside if there's nowhere to drop
- Lift-Clean-Place in your own fairway if course is wet/soggy
- Brown spot relief within one club length

<u>Pace of play</u> - it was difficult to find courses this year- reasons being pace of play. As a result, we all need to be on the same page- keeping girls with the group ahead, putting them on the clock and even assessing penalties if necessary.


- Try to limit the pre-shot routine to one or two practice swings.
- When putting, each player should putt out to avoid the extra time to mark and take turns.
- Pace of Play Guidelines (Rule 5.6b): The recommendation is to play a stroke in no more than 45 seconds. In stroke play: you may play out of turn or "ready golf" in a safe way. The committee may adopt a Local Rule setting a Pace of Play Policy to


- set a maximum time to complete a round, a hole or series of holes, and a stroke, and it may set penalties for not following the policy.
- If the group fails to keep their position on the course, then notify the group that they are "going on the clock." Then, any player who does not complete his/her turn in the allowed 45 seconds is assessed a two-stroke penalty. A second violation is another two-stroke penalty, and a third violation results in a disqualification.
- For JV & MS matches (or for home varsity match), if a group falls a hole behind the group in front of them, the entire group would move to the next tee and all players would be given a double par score for the hole they skipped.
