## Learning Acquisition and Assessment

IB History Topic 12 focuses on the Superpower Rivalry between the US and the USSR. It is impossible to discuss the Cold War without evaluating the negotiations, treaties, and alliances that took place in different regions where Cold War Crises took place. This lesson allows the Candidate to evaluate the Role these Cold War Crises played in the development and strengthening of what will become the European Union

Students will complete a Graphic Organizer that highlights certain key historical developments in the history of the EU and align them with the Cold War Crises that occurred during the same time frame. Student will then Analyze these Crises and look for the potential significance they played in the development and expansion of the EU during the Cold war.

IB History demands students to make solid historical arguments, and prepare well writing Essays for Paper 2 and Paper 3 Assessments

Upon completion of the lesson and subsequent Graphic Organizer. Students will use the skills developed in previous lesson regarding IB writing to complete a practice Paper 2 Essay utilizing the prompts from the Essential Questions.
