

Dr. Richard H. Kingery Memorial Award for Excellence in Complete Denture Prosthetics

We are pleased to announce the establishment of the **Dr. Richard H. Kingery Memorial Award** to honor the enduring legacy of Dr. Richard H. Kingery, a founding member of the American Board of Prosthodontics and former chairman of the Complete Denture Prosthetics Department (now the Department of Biologic and Materials Sciences & Prosthodontics - BMSP) at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry.

The Kingery Club, in its final act, has generously donated to Dr. Kingery's endowed memorial fund. This award is designed to recognize and support third-year prosthodontic residents who exhibit excellence in complete denture prosthetics and are planning to pursue licensure as prosthodontists. Preference will be given to those residents who hold a DDS from the University of Michigan or an undergraduate degree from Michigan State University, reflecting Dr. Kingery's academic roots.

Award Criteria:

- Open to third-year prosthodontic residents.
- Must demonstrate exceptional skill and knowledge in prosthodontics, specifically in complete denture prosthetics.
- Must be planning to become a licensed prosthodontist, with a preference for those planning to take the **American Board of Prosthodontics** exam.
- Preference will be given to residents with a DDS from the University of Michigan or an undergraduate degree from Michigan State University.

Award Details:

Awardees will be presented:

- \$1000 award
- A plaque or other suitable display within the BMSP Department, honoring their achievement and Dr. Kingery's legacy.

Application Materials:

- CV
- Dental school transcript (can be unofficial)
- Two references with contact information, at least one prosthodontist
- A statement from you, not to exceed 500 words, describing past clinical and laboratory work and your motivation, purpose, and career goal for pursuing a graduate education in prosthodontics.
- A reapplication will only require a statement of need.
