Long Term Implications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Increases students' understanding on options they have post-undergrad - By helping expand the knowledge of future opportunities, third year students will feel more secure and prepared when they start making important decisions for their future - Spreading awareness will help with third year students' confidence and agency - while uncertainty may still be present, it could help ease some worries knowing future options
