Period 1	Pudding eating contest Omnikin Volleyball	Students will stay in their homeroom and create a team name and flag for the opening ceremonies.
Period 2	kettle boil relay	Juniors and seniors will do half an hour of each activity. The pudding contest will take place in the cafeteria. Volleyball will take place in the gym
Period 3	Outdoor activities: Snow Sculpture Contest Tug of war Three-legged race snowball accuracy Race with snowshoes and a snowball on a spoon.	Homerooms will compete to build a fire and boil a kettle full of water. See the rules below.
Period 4&5	Skating at OP rink.	To do: Mark start and end points for races. Set up Snowball accuracy throwing points and target. Find snow shoes Get spoons

Rules for kettle boil relay

1. Choose your runners
 - a. 5 Runners to obtain materials
2. Line up the runners at the start line in their running order.
3. Run to location of supplies
 - a. Different people must run to get items.
 - b. Your team decides what items you pick up first.
 - c. Pick up one item at a time and return to the start/finish line
4. Teams can start preparing to light the fire as soon as runners arrive at the designated fire location with supplies.
5. The first team to have their kettle to a rolling boil... (big bubbles not just little bubbles) will be declared the winner and so on for 2nd and 3rd.
6. If an accelerant or any substance is used or any supplies other than what is supplied are used the team will be disqualified and may forfeit the points accumulated from other events... and will be subject to a five year ban from boiling the kettle.... Even at home.... With an electric kettle... Have fun play safe...

You will have the following supplies:

Bottle of water
Kettle
Wood
Cardboard
Matches
