

Final Metrics for Success

The Gorham School Committee would like to establish the following overarching goals to measure the “success” of our [Mission/vision](#) and [Strategic Plan](#) work.

1. 100% of all GHS students have a post-graduation plan that includes acceptance to a college, apprenticeship, trade school, military, or volunteer opportunity (e.g. Americorps) OR have full-time employment upon graduation.
2. Maintain a graduation rate higher than the mean of Cumberland County School Districts.
3. All students across grades K-12 meet the requirements of our “[Portrait of a Graduate](#)” when exiting the transition years of Gr. 5, 8, and 12.
 - a. If not yet meeting, the school will respond with RTI and other supportive measures
4. GSD maintains above-average scores (above the mean) in the state and Cumberland County on required standardized tests across all grades and contents.
5. Qualitative and quantitative data will continue to indicate that a majority of students, parents, and staff feel positive about our school and district culture.
6. Reports from our PE/PG Danielson Teacher Evaluation System Domain 1(Planning & Preparation), 2 (Classroom Environment), 3 (Instruction), & 4 (Professional Responsibilities) will indicate teachers are achieving a 3 or higher in all indicators.
