General Information:

A show should have at least 1 hr - 1 hr 30 Min of entertainment. We look to low cost opportunities so that our tickets can cover the cost of the event.

- A variety entertainment program using local college dance/ music groups
 - Local Universities have excellent Bhangra/ Raas/ Bollywood and other dance teams that may be available to perform.
 - They also have South Asian Acapella and Bands that can present very entertaining programs.
- Local Dance Schools
 - Local Indian dance schools often are able to put together dance ballets or dance shows that are entertaining
- Local Musicians/ Bands
 - Many talented local musicians can put together a Bollywood music program
- Mix/Match Variety Entertainment Program. Here is an example
 - A couple of dances/ Acapella from local Universities
 - A fashion show featuring local people - We can replicate the very thoughtful show done at the National Ekal Conference, in Atlanta where the leading women of India through the ages (Eg. the first Woman Indian Doctor, Astronaut, Air Force Officer, Indra Nooyi and others) were depicted.
 - Local music group - Karaoke Presentation
 - Standup comedy
- Options from Ekal Central
 - There are musical groups in Boston, Connecticut, Raleigh and other areas who would be willing to travel and perform for Ekal.
 - There is a fashion show that was put together at the National Conference that can be replicated at the different events. We will share the video. This may be a good way to bring local people into the event
