

VOLLEYBALL, GIRLS AND BOYS BASKETBALL CASTLEBERRY HIGH SCHOOL GYMNASIUM



The Castleberry High School gymnasium seats 1071 people with 756 on the home side and 365 on the visitor side. There will be no cash sales at the gate. Tickets can only be purchased online from the CISD website and each team will be provided with a link for their fans to purchase tickets before the game. The gate will open 1 hour prior to game time.

The cost is **\$500** and includes the use of the facility, dressing rooms, and the Castleberry Athletic Booster Club will open the concession stand. Teams may arrive 1 ½ hours prior to game time.

Castleberry ISD will provide the following workers at **additional costs**: game administrator, scoreboard operator, scorebook, libero tracker (VB), announcer, ticket sellers, ticket verifiers, Police/security, bag search officer, custodian.

Teams are responsible for acquiring the officials and Castleberry will include those costs and the UIL 16 % (BB only) into final costs and split between the 2 schools participating.

CAMP CARTER ATHLETIC COMPLEX

BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL



Castleberry ISD renovated the Camp Carter Athletic Complex for Baseball and Softball in the Fall of 2022, adding new turf, dugouts, bleachers, and batting cages. New LED lighting was updated in 2021 and the fields opened for the 2023 seasons.

Baseball Dimensions and Seating Capacity:

- a. Seats: 508
- b. Field Dimensions: Left - 297 / Center - 345 / Right - 299

Softball Dimensions and Seating Capacity:

- a. Seats: 491
- b. Field Dimensions: Left - 180 / Center 178 / Right - 180

The following rules will be enforced:

Playing Field

- a. No food, chewing gum, or sunflower seeds are permitted.
- b. No tobacco of any kind is permitted.
- c. No open flames or fireworks permitted.
- d. Turf shoes or molded cleats are suitable.
- e. No metal cleats allowed.
- f. Vehicles that are permitted on the turf field include only:
 - i. Golf Carts
 - ii. Small Utility Vehicles (gators)
- g. Tents must be free standing structures (No stakes may be used to support any tents)
- h. Metal chair legs must be protected by rubber end tips and cannot contain any jagged edges.

- i. Team benches should have the rubber ends on the tubing to avoid possibly tearing the turf.
- j. Only team and district personnel may be inside the turf area.
- k. All shoes or athletic footwear must be clear of all mud and debris.
- l. No animals of any kind are permitted on the turf area.

Cost - The cost is **\$800 (\$1400 for 2 games and \$1800 for 3 game series)** and includes the use of the facility and the Castleberry Athletic Booster Club will open the concession stand. Teams may arrive 1 ½ hours prior to game time. Castleberry ISD will provide the following workers at **additional costs**: game administrator, scoreboard operator/announcer, scorebook, ticket sellers, ticket verifiers, Police/security, bag search officer, custodian.

Items of interest regarding Castleberry ISD W.O. Barnes Stadium:

Playing Surface:

- Playing surface is Field Turf (Put down in 2018)

Stadium Seating:

- 1724 bench seats available on Home Side (plus 382 individual seats)
- 1304 bench seats are available on the Visitor side

Ticketing:

- ALL ticket sales will be ONLINE. Castleberry ISD will provide the teams with a link for ticket sales. No cash sales at the game. Gates open 1 ½ hours before game time for spectators

Press Box:

- Section 1: Home coaches box
- Section 2: Media and Game Operations
- Section 3: Radio and film deck (enclosed with open garage window)
- Section 4: Visitor coaches box

Football Cost:

- **\$2500** for the stadium use, locker rooms, & concession stands to open

Football Additional Costs:

Gold Ball Trophy, Game administrator, Team Assistants (2), Clock operator, 25/40 sec clock operator, chain crew, PA Announcer, Ticket sellers & verifiers, Police/security, Bag search officer, Custodians, Officials, 16% UIL fee

Football UIL Fees:

- 16% added to rental costs

Soccer Cost:

- **\$800** for the stadium use, locker rooms, & concession stands to open

Soccer Additional Costs:

Game administrator, Team Assistants (2), Clock operator, PA Announcer, Ticket sellers & verifiers, Police/security, Bag search officer, Custodians, Officials

Game Officials:

- The Home and Visiting Teams will arrange for game officials. Please let CISD know which official's chapter will be calling the game.
- Fees for officials will be added to rental cost

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W.O. Barnes Stadium Regulations (Football and Soccer)

Dressing Rooms

- a. Castleberry I.S.D. will NOT provide towels.
- b. Castleberry I.S.D. is not responsible for any articles left in the dressing room before, during, or after the game.

Ticket Gates

- a. Gates will open 1 ½ hours prior to game time.
- b. There are no in-and-out privileges; re-entry requires the purchase of a new ticket.
- c. Castleberry I.S.D. Stadium is a tobacco free facility and tobacco use is prohibited.

Press Box

- a. Admittance to the press box is by *Press Box Pass* only. There is one exception: Coaches with *Sideline Passes* wearing proper coaching attire do not need *Press Box Passes* to enter press box.
- b. The press box will open 1 ½ hours prior to game time.

Playing Field

- a. No food, chewing gum, or sunflower seeds are permitted.
- b. No tobacco of any kind is permitted.
- c. No open flames or fireworks permitted.
- d. Turf shoes or molded cleats are suitable.
- e. No metal cleats allowed.
- f. Vehicles that are permitted on the turf field include only:
 - i. Golf Carts
 - ii. Small Utility Vehicles (gators)
- g. No high heel shoes are permitted.
- h. Tents must be free standing structures (No stakes may be used to support any tents)
- i. Metal chair legs must be protected by rubber end tips and cannot contain any jagged edges.
- j. Team benches should have the rubber ends on the tubing to avoid possibly tearing the turf.

- k. Only team and district personnel may be inside the turf area.
- l. All shoes or athletic footwear must be clear of all mud and debris.
- m. No bicycles, roller blades, or skateboards will be permitted.
- n. No animals of any kind are permitted on the turf area.
- m. No soccer corner flags with spikes driven into the turf area.

Miscellaneous

- a. All team personnel that are not in game uniform must have a *Sideline Pass*. This includes coaches, trainers, student trainers, student managers, and any other support staff. Cheerleaders that are in game uniforms do not need a pass, but any support staff not in uniform must have a *Sideline Pass*.
- b. All equipment such as training tables, fans, and heaters must have a protective base. Please make prior arrangements with the stadium manager.
- c. No live mascots are allowed.
- d. All large mechanical noisemakers, i.e., large air horns, must be on your own side (west end zone) and face your spectators.
- e. Band props must not mark or scar the field. This includes painted items as well as sharp wheels or other equipment that may damage the surface.
- f. No Ice chests will be allowed in the stadium. Exceptions include the competing teams, bands, drill teams, and cheerleaders.

Stadium Bleachers

- a. Absolutely no climbing or jumping over rails from the bleachers to the field.
- b. Absolutely no crossover by spectators from home side of stadium to visitor side of stadium or vice-versa.
- c. Spirit signs used in the bleachers must be made of vinyl or cloth with permanent paint that does not run when wet.
- d. Location of Spirit signs:
 - i. Visitors – North side (Top rail)
 - ii. Home – South side (ex. A/C/B) (Top Rail)
 - West End Zone

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W.O. Barnes Stadium Rules

1. **NO LOITERING**. All spectators will need to be seated in the stadium during the course of any athletic event. This change will impact students and young children who have traditionally gathered in areas around the stadium or under the bleachers.
2. **ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, WEAPONS AND FIREARMS** are not allowed, by state law, on school property.
3. **OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK** is not allowed in the stadium, including bottled water.
4. **JACKETS, BACK PACKS AND LARGE BAGS** are subject to search.

CISD Safety & Security Measure Notice:

To ensure the safety of the students, staff, and patrons at ALL Castleberry High School athletic contests, Castleberry Independent School District has implemented bag checks.

All spectators and volunteers attending tonight's contest is subject to a bag check.

5. **AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY** will be admitted onto the field before, during, or after the game.
6. **AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY** will be allowed to cross over to the opposing side.
7. **ANIMALS, BICYCLES, SKATES, SKATEBOARDS, FRISBEES, ROLLERBLADES, AND BALLS OF ALL TYPES** are not allowed in the stadium.
8. **OUTSIDE MUSIC/PA SYSTEMS** are not allowed in the stadium.
9. While fun, enjoyment and school spirit are important, safety remains a priority at Castleberry I.S.D. These rules were established to enhance crowd control and safety.
