Measure 27 is a statutory citizen-initiated measure that will appear on South Dakota's 2022 general election ballot. Read the full text of the measure here.

What the measure does

- Permits adults 21 years of age or older to possess up to one ounce of cannabis, with no more than eight grams in concentrated form; and
- Allows adults to cultivate up to three cannabis plants (no more than six plants per residence) in jurisdictions where there are no retail cannabis stores.

What the measure does not do

- Establish a regulatory and taxation system for adult-use cannabis;
- Require employers to change their workplace drug use policies; or
- Permit public consumption of marijuana, unless permitted by statute.
