Below is list of the attributes used by the social scientist to predict occupation obcelence. These are the attributes found in occupations that are predicted to still have an high probability of being populated by human employees in the near future.

1. Perception and Manipulation:

A. Finger Dexterity: The ability to make precisely coordinated movements of the fingers of one or both hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble very small objects.

B. Manual Dexterity The ability to quickly move your hand, your hand together with your arm, or your two hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble objects.

C. Cramped Work Space and awkward Positions: How often does this job require working in cramped work spaces that requires getting into awkward positions?

2. Creative Intelligence and Originality:

A. The ability to come up with unusual or clever ideas about a given topic or situation, or to develop creative ways to solve a problem.

B. Fine Arts Knowledge of theory and techniques required to compose, produce, and perform works of music, dance, visual arts, drama, and sculpture.

3. Social Intelligence and Social Perceptiveness:

A. Being aware of others' reactions and understanding why they react as they do.

B. Negotiation bringing others together and trying to reconcile differences.

C. Persuasion persuading others to change their minds or behavior.

D. Assisting and caring for others providing personal assistance, medical attention, emotional support, or other personal care to others such as coworkers, customers, or patients.
