### **Overview:**

## Before the lesson students (warm up):

- listen to the model dialogue and check your understanding multiple choice and fill typing;
- discuss the manners at the cinema;

#### After the lesson students:

• write a film review using Canva

The aim of the lesson: deepen learners' knowledge of how to express opinions and attitudes using a range of expressions and sentences, create the opportunity for learners to follow an everyday conversation about films, genres and mannners to respond to ideas and suggestions in informal discussions using their digital literacy skills for brainstorming ideas.
