General

When and where is camp held?

Camp runs June 29 – August 14, 2026, at A.Y. Jackson Secondary School in North York. Each week has its own theme — you can register for individual weeks or all six.

What ages is camp open to?

The Basketball Stream is open to athletes ages 8–15. Campers are grouped by a combination of age and ability, so everyone is appropriately challenged.

What are the camp hours?

The regular camp day runs 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. FREE early drop-off is available starting at 8:00 a.m. Standard late pick-up runs until 4:00 p.m. Extended care until 5:00 p.m. is available for an additional fee (\$60 for 5-day weeks, \$50 for 4-day weeks).

Is there an option to register for half days or individual days?

We do not allow registration for half days or individual days because of how we structure not just our camp days but also our camp weeks.

Registration & Payment

How do I register?

Complete the online registration form and pay by credit card. Your spot is not confirmed until payment is received.

Can I register for multiple weeks?

Yes — you can register for any combination of weeks. If you're registering for all six weeks (Foundation through The Complete Player), select the bundle option to save \$350.

Is there a registration deadline?

There is no hard deadline, but t-shirt sizes cannot be guaranteed for registrations received on or after June 1, 2026, as apparel orders are placed on June 2.

Do you offer any discounts?

Yes — registering for all six weeks (Weeks 1–6) at once gives you a discounted rate of \$2,250, saving \$350 off the individual week prices.

What's Included

Is lunch provided?

No, campers should bring their own lunch each day. Pizza Fridays are available for purchase for those who want it.

What does my child receive with registration?

Every camper receives a camp t-shirt, a daily math workbook, access to camp competitions and prizes, free early drop-off, and the option to register for OVO Camp Day on July 10 and July 21.

What is the math program?

Each day includes a 30-minute math session led by a tutor. Workbooks are provided. This is a core part of our whole-athlete development philosophy — we believe academic growth and athletic growth go hand in hand.

What is OVO Camp Day?

OVO Camp Day is an optional special event available on July 10 and July 21. Details on how to register are provided after camp registration is complete.

Cancellations & Refunds

What is your refund policy?

Cancellations must be sent to info@pbaa.ca. Refunds are subject to the following:

- Before February 28: Full refund minus a \$50 administrative fee
- February 28 – April 30: Full refund minus a \$100 administrative fee
- After April 30: No refunds, except for medical reasons

What if my child has to withdraw for medical reasons?

If your child cannot attend due to a serious injury or illness, a partial refund or pro-rated credit toward a future camp may be provided. A doctor's note is required. Contact Monique Phillips at info@pbaa.ca.

Health & Safety

What should I do if my child has allergies or a medical condition?

Please disclose any allergies, medical conditions, or recent injuries in the registration form. Our staff will be made aware so they can support your child appropriately.

What happens in a medical emergency?

Our staff are trained to respond to emergencies on-site. If necessary, emergency medical services will be contacted. By completing registration, parents authorize emergency medical treatment if we are unable to reach them.
