Articles of Impeachment 1.41: Calling for the Removal of Senator Bodhi Small

Introduced: February 9, 2020

Sponsors: Ben Garfield '22 (primary), Katelin Penner '22, Sam Brumer '22

Understanding that Senator Bodhi Small has opted to go without resigning from the Wesleyan Student Assembly (WSA) despite not being enrolled as a Wesleyan student in the Spring 2020 semester;

Noticing that, given that Senator Small will be abroad in Germany, is not enrolled at Wesleyan, is not on campus, has accrued 3 unexcused absences between General Assembly and Committee meetings, and has committed an impeachable offense;

Condemning the lack of respect that Senator Small's decision not to resign shows for the WSA;

The Wesleyan Student Assembly (WSA),

1. Removes Senator Bodhi Small from the WSA.

Articles of Impeachment are a piece of legislation voted on by the Senate that states that the WSA has voted to remove a Senator from the GA. The author(s) of the Articles of Impeachment are responsible for presenting the Articles to the Chief of Staff, who, upon receipt of the Articles, will now consider the Senator implicated in the Articles as impeached, and shall notify the impeached Senator within 3 days of receipt. At the next meeting of the GA, impeachment proceedings shall take place. If following the vote of the GA, two-thirds of Senators vote to remove the impeached Senator, the impeached Senator shall be removed and the College Body will be notified of the removal and of the start of the process to appoint or elect a replacement Senator.
