What signs showed us the Holy Spirit is present?

The mighty wind, the tongues of fire, all languages spoken and understood

What does Peter include in his sermon? (v 2:14-38)

1. The disciples are not drunk (v 14)
2. Words from Joel an old testament prophet- making connections to the old testament and traditions( v.17-21)
3. Jesus proved himself to be God's son by coming back from the dead (v 22)
4. You crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. (v 23)
5. God raised him up. (v 24)
6. He compares David to Jesus. David both died and was buried and his tomb is with us to this day. (v. 29)
7. What should we do? repent and be baptized. (v. 38)

What was life like for early believers? (v.2: 42-47)

The broke bread together- Communion The did everything together

What do Peter and John do that is amazing? (3:1-10)

They healed a lame guy.

Peter turns this into a teachable moment. How does he respond to the people who see it happen? ( 3: 12-26)

He proclaims God's power

Peter is arrested and has to answer to the council for his actions. How does he respond? (v 4:8-12) How does the council respond? (v 4:13-21)

Peter says I can't stop talking about God, the council lets him go.
