Timeline

Week 1: January 17

- Internship term begins

Week 5: February 13

- Students encouraged to begin discussing scholarship with site supervisor

Week 9: March 20

- Scholarship application opens (check Rebelmail)

Week 13: April 24

- Apr. 24 Scholarship application final reminder to apply
- Apr. 30 Scholarship application closes; recommendation letters due

Week 14: May 1-12

- Applications under review

Week 15: May 12

- Internship term ends; scholarship recipients announced

FAQ	Answer
Scholarship amount	\$1500.00
Eligibility	Current COLA 402 intern in good standing; must be matched directly with a COLA internship site (not self-secured); must answer surveys, successfully pass COLA 402, and successfully complete assigned internship term (minimum 120 internship hours). Seniors graduating during the semester of their internship are ineligible.
Recipients	Three undergraduate interns per internship term
Scholarship limit	Interns may only receive this scholarship once during their academic career.
Usage of funds	The Internship Scholarship will be applied directly to students' MyUNLV balance. If there is no balance owed, then funds may be directly deposited, or a physical check may be mailed to the student.
Letter of recommendation	Interns must request a letter of recommendation from their current internship site supervisor. Feel free to review this course on best practices via LinkedIn Learning .
