 - December meeting highlights:
 - celebrated Annie, who left the board; swore in Beth and Ava as new trustees (4-yr); Amir selected as President; Beth as VP; Natalie as clerk;
 - Approved LCMSD Vision and reviewed first interim budget; budget study workshop upcoming; question is "what we would want to do differently in upcoming years"
 - Standards based grading at Hall board looking at implementation; got first feedback/pulse survey from parents/students/staff. Want to implement it in a way that makes it the most actionable
 - Starting January, review of data learning labs tier 1 programming/curriculum
 review data and support for teachers
 - January board meeting in a few weeks; budget workshop in February
 - All welcome to come to board meeting with questions or share feedback

- Had meeting with architect who designed Cove and modernized NC and Hall
- Approval to sketch out fencing options for all 3 sites
- Discussing potential fencing options
- Anticipate getting plans this month or next, then will schedule community meeting for each school
- Hanover and Keenan assessment moving thru recommendations
- Controlled access camera out front with way to communicate with office staff to be buzzed in; School staff will have access to enter without being buzzed in
- Idea to funnel community to front office to enter school
- Debrief on tsunami response
- Budget update 1st interim report presented at December meeting (thru 10/31);
 board and district have done a lot of work over the years to have a balanced budget;
 looking at 3-year projection, we are balanced in year 3 (deficit spending this year and next, but intentionally so); on target with the plan.
