Put your board "entries" into a Google Slide presentation and clearly label each item with the square you chose.

Read at least 100 pages in a self selected book. Type a short summary about the section you read.	Read a picture book to a younger child or pet. Upload a picture of you reading to them. Make sure the book title is showing!	Handwrite a letter/card to a family member, friend, etc. telling them why you are thankful for them. Upload a picture of your letter/card.
Read a recipe and make the item in the recipe. Remember to read the whole recipe through before you start. What did you make? How did it turn out? Upload a picture of you cooking and the recipe and a picture of the dish.	Ask an older relative or friend to tell you a story about his or her childhood. Upload a picture of them. Record their story (either audio or written). You might want it later. Upload the audio or a picture of part of their story.	Tweet, Facebook, Instagram, or Snapchat about a book you're reading. Upload a screenshot of the post.
Go to the public library and check out their awesome book selection. If you don't have a library card, sign up for one. Upload a "shelfie" of you in the library.	Listen to a podcast or TedTalk about whatever you want. There are a ton out there! Post a link to the podcast/TedTalk for reference. (The podcast episode should be at least 10 minutes.) Title of the podcast-Title of the episode- What is something you learned? What is something you found interesting?	Watch a movie based off of a book (it should be a book that you have read). Rate the movie 1-5 stars and write a 7 sentence review. How is the book similar or different to the movie?
