V. Meeting Topic: Amazon ordering

How are you handling Amazon ordering in Acq?

- Mary: Manually creating purchase orders. Using federated search to find bibs.
- Jennifer: Same here. Using a combination of brief records on POs and using the View/Place order from the catalog. Recommend to librarians not to use federated search.
- Tiffany: We never see the vandelay page when we activate when items have 'link to catalog', Christine from the Co-cop said that this might be a permission issue
- Mary: Federated search cuts down on typing and entering manually. Most successful when searching local catalog.
- Jennifer: If federated search went away and we had a better interface via Z39.50. If use sources that need username/pw, no way to enter credentials. Wishlist: would be to have an option on Z39.50 to create a purchase order/create line item.
  - Jane: You can set a username/password for MARC federated search in Server Admin > Z39.50 Servers > click the source > Apply Credentials. May be able to set by org unit.
- Mary: Would like a permission set for that.
- Jane: We tried federated search for a while, but it was really annoying because of this bug: <a href="https://bugs.launchpad.net/evergreen/+bug/1768846">https://bugs.launchpad.net/evergreen/+bug/1768846</a>
- Christine: Use Z39.50, you can search local catalog and sources. If you find a result in EG, you can click on Opac View and then do View/Place Order. If don't find native record, then you can import into the catalog and then do View/Place Order. So for libraries that don't care about on-order items, they don't do a purchase order; they just create an invoice and catalog as the items come in.
- Tiffany: Possible solution: download your order history via csv and finesse in MarcEdit to create (really) brief .mrc files. Send Elaine's template to Eg-Acq <--ACTION ITEM</li>
  - Jennifer: Could use distribution formulas to assist with this. Even single branch libraries can use it as well!

- Jennifer: Could MarcEdit have multiple templates? Like one for books where it puts in the 020 \$a and one for DVDS, etc.
- Nsahib: Do manual purchase orders in EG to encumber money, then order directly
