Additional Checklist Items

When you're ready to complete your application in Cal State Apply, be sure you have these items on hand:

- ☐ Social Security number, if you have one.

- ☐ Citizenship status
- ☐ Method of payment. You can pay the application fee by credit card.
- ☐ Annual income

Minimum Admission Requirements*

- ☐ Possess a bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited institution. If the degree was obtained outside of the United States, the degree conferring institution must be recognized by the home country's ministry of education and degree coursework must be WES evaluated.*
- ☐ Complete prerequisite courses or their equivalent including:
 - Nutrition and Metabolism (NUFD 113);
 - Nutrition: Preconception Through Childhood (NUFD 115) or Nutrition: Adolescence Through Older Adulthood (NUFD 119);
 - Community Nutrition (NUFD 117) or Nutrition Education, Communication, and Counseling (NUFD 107);
 - Food Service Management (NUFD 116) or Food Production and Sustainability (NUFD 110); and
 - Introduction to Statistics (STAT 1) or Research: Methods and Application in Nutrition and Food (NUFD 100)
- ☐ Have a GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 semester units
