INT. RESTAURANT - NIGHT

MAX  
(raising his glass)  
To us.

LILY  
(toasting)  
To us.

Their eyes meet, and they lean in for a kiss. Suddenly, a loud noise interrupts them. A man bursts into the restaurant, brandishing a gun.

MAX  
(shocked and frightened)  
What the hell is happening?

The man starts shouting and demanding money. Max, trying to be the hero, attempts to disarm the man. In the ensuing struggle, Max is shot.

Lily screams in terror as Max falls to the ground, bleeding. The police arrive and apprehend the criminal, but it's too late. Max is rushed to the hospital, but he doesn't make it.

INT. FUNERAL HOME - DAY

Lily stands in front of Max's casket, tears streaming down her face. She can't believe that the love of her life is gone forever.

LILY  
(voice trembling)  
I'll never forget you, Max. You were the light of my life.

Days turn into weeks, and Lily finds herself spiraling into depression. She can't eat, can't sleep, can't focus on anything else but Max. She visits his grave every day, talking to him as if he were still there.

INT. THERAPIST'S OFFICE - DAY

Lily sits in a therapist's office, staring blankly at the wall. The therapist tries to talk to her, but she's unresponsive.

THERAPIST  
(concerned)

Lily, you need to let go. Max wouldn't want you to live like this.

Lily looks up, her eyes red and swollen.

LILY

(angrily)

Don't tell me what Max would want! You don't know anything about us.

THERAPIST

(gently)

I'm sorry, Lily. I just want to help you.

LILY

(defeated)

I know. I'm sorry. I just can't seem to move on.

INT. LILY'S APARTMENT - NIGHT

Lily sits on her couch, staring at a picture of her and Max. She takes a bottle of pills out of her purse and looks at them for a moment. Then, she puts them back and starts crying.

LILY

(sobbing)

I can't do this anymore, Max. I can't live without you.

Suddenly, she hears a knock on the door.

Lily hesitates for a moment, unsure if she wants to answer the door. But the knocking continues, becoming more persistent.

Finally, she gets up from the couch and walks to the door. She opens it to reveal a man standing on her doorstep. It's David, Max's best friend.

DAVID

(concerned)

Lily, are you okay? I heard what happened, and I've been worried about you.

Lily looks at David, tears streaming down her face.

LILY

(broken)

I can't do this, David. I can't live without him.

David steps into the apartment and embraces Lily, holding her as she cries.

DAVID

(whispering)

I know it's hard, Lily. But you can't give up. Max wouldn't want that.

Lily pulls away from David and looks at him.

LILY

(angrily)

How would you know what Max would want? You didn't even know we were together!

David looks at Lily, taken aback by her outburst.

DAVID

(apologetically)

I'm sorry, Lily. I didn't mean to upset you.

LILY

(softening)

I'm sorry, David. I just miss him so much.

David takes a deep breath and looks at Lily with a determined expression.

DAVID

(resolutely)

Lily, I know this might sound crazy, but I have an idea. There's a place I want to take you, somewhere Max and I used to go when we were kids. I think it might help you find some peace.

Lily looks at David, intrigued by his proposal.

LILY

(curious)

Where is this place?

DAVID

(smirking)

It's a secret. But trust me, it's worth it.

INT. DAVID'S CAR - DAY

Lily sits in the passenger seat of David's car, looking out the window as they drive. David has a mischievous look on his face.

LILY

(nervously)

Are you sure this is a good idea?

DAVID

(confidently)

Positive. Just wait until you see it.

They arrive at a secluded spot in the woods, and David parks the car. He leads Lily through the trees, holding her hand.

They come to a clearing, and Lily gasps in amazement. It's a beautiful waterfall, surrounded by wildflowers and a crystal-clear pool.

LILY

(astonished)

DAVID
