Shin Megami Tensei is a Japanese media franchise owned by Atlus and primarily consists of role-playing games, of which most notably includes the spinoff *Persona* series. SMT started in 1987 with the release of the first installment, *Digital Devil Story: Megami Tensei* and is continuing strong until 2021, with *Shin Megami Tensei V*, which is set to release on the Nintendo Switch in November 2021.

The *Nasuverse* is a nickname for all Type-Moon works and is named after the creator, Kinoko Nasu. Type-Moon's most known work is the Fate franchise, which includes several visual novels, animated series and films and games. The franchise begins with the release of *Kara no Kyoukai*, a visual novel released in 1998. Currently, Type-Moon is working on a remake of Fate/EXTRA, Tsukhime ~a piece of blue glass moon~, and Melty Blood:Type Lumina, all set to be released sometime in 2021.

Both of these franchises contain different depictions of mythical and historical figures from several cultures. I wanted to compare how some historical/mythical figures are represented/incorporated between Shin Megami Tensei and Type-Moon.
