How do you make Shibboleth Highly Available?

F5 Load Balancer

Terracotta

Apache httpd which proxies to Tomcat

How do you make CAS Highly Available?

Northeastern University

Oracle database replication for service registry and tickets cache

Tomcat replication for sessions

Nebraska-Lincoln Static JSON service registry Use memcached for tickets

How long are your CAS sessions?

30 min or less (2)

3 hours or less (3)

more than three hours (4) 8-10 hours (one work day) (2) three weeks (1) (Unicon helped on this integration)

Alternatives, protect Use Shibboleth as IdP for CAS Paul, Indiana University Pennsylvania

What versions of the Shib IdP are you running?

Cal Poly

- 2.1 in prod, java 6, tomcat, using terra cotta for sharing between three
- 2.4 in dev, discovered that terracotta doesn't run on Java 7

Alternatives to Terracotta?

Memcached

Will Shibboleth v3 support the CAS protocol? Yes.

Institutions considering consolidating their CAS & Shib IdP deployments with v3: 6 institutions, possible future work

For those implementing now, instead of synchronizing sessions for shib, simply delegate auth to CAS and handle session synchronization at that level. https://github.com/Unicon/shib-cas-authn2
