

ILLMA E. YOUNG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Application

What is the Illma E. Young memorial scholarship?

The Illma E. Young Memorial Scholarship is a merit and financial need based scholarship honoring the memory of Illma E. Young of Oconto, Wisconsin.

Over the course of Mrs. Young's life she served as a tireless leader for the American Gold Star Mothers, which is dedicated to mothers who have lost a child in the U.S. Armed Services. Illma served as the president of both the Wisconsin branch and the Oconto WI Chapter, and helped many women work through their personal loss. Illma was also a steadfast leader and member of the Oconto First Presbyterian Church and served across a number of leadership roles and as a church deacon.

However, Mrs. Young did all of these things not for the formal titles or accolades. She was genuinely committed to her friends, family and community and never wavered in her support, love and understanding to their health and happiness.

Applicants to the Illma E. Young Memorial Scholarship are self-nominated and one applicant annually will be recognized with a one-time scholarship award from the John Schmit and Megan Foret Foundation for their pursuit of a post-secondary education.

One scholarship award of \$2,000 will be given for the upcoming academic school year. This will be paid directly to the award recipient in two \$1,000 installments. The first installment will be paid in May/June. The second installment requires proof of a 2.667 GPA on a minimum of 12 academic credits during their first semester, as well as proof of enrollment for the second semester.

What are the guidelines to be eligible for the award?

Eligible applicants must:

- Be a graduating high school senior attending Oconto or Lena, Wisconsin High School
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above
- Demonstrate leadership abilities in school, work, community, or extra-curricular activities
- Be accepted to and plan to attend an accredited non-profit post-secondary college, university, or vocational/technical school in the United States
- Have demonstrated financial need for higher education as demonstrated by the Student Aid Index (SAI) on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

What are we looking for in scholarship candidates?

Successful candidates are committed to academic excellence and are responsible and caring leaders. Strong consideration will be given to students' unique circumstances and economic need as demonstrated by their EFC and personal essay.

How can scholarship funds be used?

Scholarship funds may be used for "qualified" educational expenses as defined by the IRS, and include tuition, required books and equipment, and required student activity fees. For more

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information on qualified educational expenses please consult IRS Publication 970 on Tax Benefits for Education.

Are there any other scholarship benefits?

In addition to the scholarship award, the John Schmit and Megan Foret Foundation will offer award recipients optional guidance and mentorship through your college experience. This aspect of the award will be tailored to the needs of the recipient and will be discussed in more detail when the individual is notified of selection for an award.

How do you apply?

To be considered for an award all applicants must complete the full application below and return the completed application, a copy of their high-school academic transcripts, and a copy of their college or university acceptance letter in electronic format to
