Dear Parent/Guardian:

This letter is to notify you that your child may have had a low-risk contact with someone who tested positive for COVID-19. According to the Mount Olive Health Department, you do not need to take any additional precautions at this time.

If you believe your child may have COVID-19 or becomes symptomatic, please contact his or her primary care doctor for directions. Most people who are mildly or moderately ill with COVID-19 will be able to safely recover at home.
