Course Description: A Marine Science course explores the ocean's interconnected systems, encompassing its physics, chemistry, geology, and biology, and how these aspects interact. It delves into marine life, from microscopic organisms to large mammals, and examines the physical and chemical processes shaping the marine environment. The field also addresses the impact of human activities on the oceans and the importance of marine conservation. Learning will occur through the use of laboratory techniques, inquiry and problem solving processes, as well as hands-on activities. These practices include the use of math skills (see common core standards) in the form of data collection, data display, and analysis which are at the core of the scientific method. Ethical issues and controversial topics will be discussed from various perspectives.

Grading: Students will earn points from the following assignments: daily bell work, daily exit passes, class work, journals, homework, essays, research projects/presentations, quizzes/exams, lab activities and lab reports. There is a lot of work but a lot of reward!

All work is weighted equally. Work will be graded on a 10 point scale: A= 100%-90%, B= 89%-80%, C= 79%-70%, D= 69%-60%, F= 59% and below. Since all assignments are weighted equally, being conscientious about completing classwork and homework can make up for a bad test grade.
