Travel Information

Airports

The nearest airport is the [Pullman-Moscow Regional Airport](#) (airport code: PUW). It's a small airport so there are only a few flights a day.

The [Spokane International Airport](#) (airport code: GEG) is about a 1 hour and 45 min drive from Pullman; you may want to rent a car as no known buses offer service from Spokane to Pullman in July.

The [Lewiston Airport](#) (airport code: LWS) is another option, but it is a little over a 45 min drive from Pullman and limited flights.

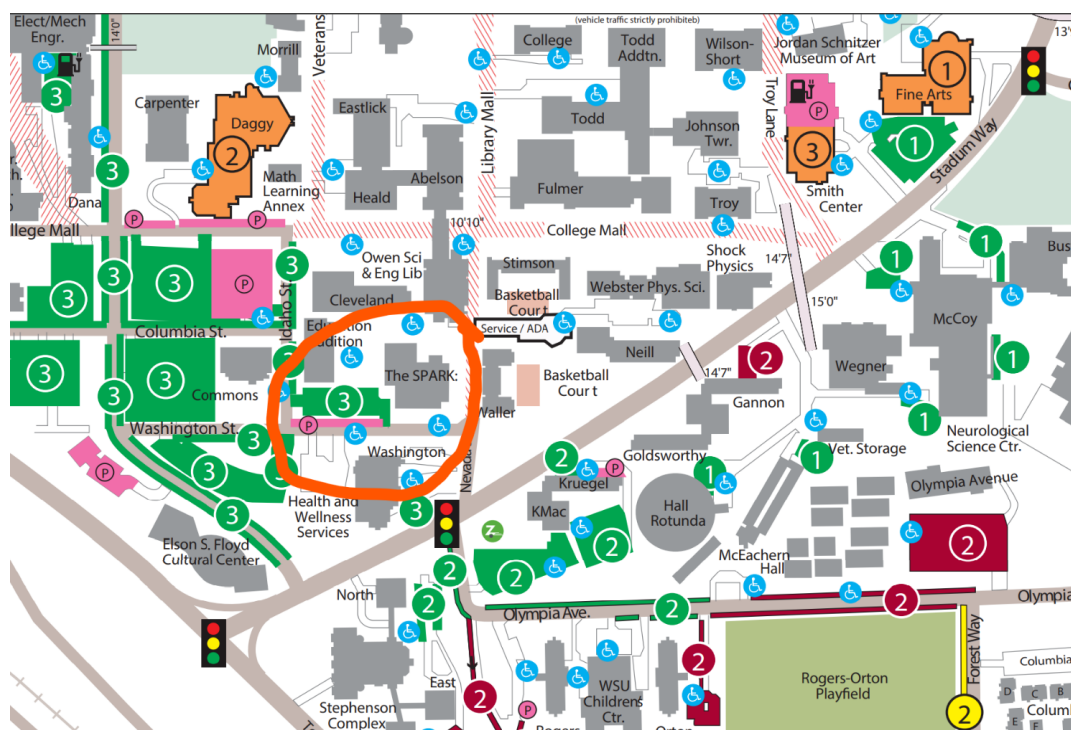
The Residence Inn by Marriott is a short walk from the Courtyard Hotel.

Walking

The Spark Building is 1.3 miles from the Courtyard Hotel. Much of the walk is on the WSU campus and is fairly pleasant. It can take some time though, so plan accordingly.

Driving

We don't recommend driving because parking on campus requires a permit and space may be difficult to find. If you do, however, wish to drive, we recommend you park at the nearby Green 3 lot (circled below):
