Developmental Disabilities Waivers

- ❖ The Day Support Waiver is now called the **Building Independence Waiver**:
 - This waiver is for adults (18+) able to live independently in the community. Individuals own, lease, or control their own living arrangements and supports are complemented by non-waiver-funded rent subsidies. Supports are episodic/periodic in nature.
- ❖ The DD Waiver is now called the **Family & Individual Supports Waiver**:
 - This waiver is for Individuals living with their families, friends, or in their own homes, including supports for those with some medical or behavioral needs. Available to both children and adults.
- ❖ The ID Waiver is now called the **Community Living Waiver**:
 - 24/7 services and supports for individuals with complex medical and/or behavioral support needs through licensed services. Includes residential supports and a full array of medical, behavioral, and non-medical supports. Available to adults and some children.

Individuals may be on the waitlist for years dependent on level of need, as level of need changes so does placement on the waiver wait list priority list.

Legal Assistance

Child in Need of Services/Supervision (CHINS) petition- A parent/guardian may file a CHINS petition if their child meets one of the following definitions:

- ❖ A Child In Need of Services means a juvenile whose behavior, conduct, or condition presents or results in a serious threat to the juvenile's well-being and physical safety; AND the conduct complained of must present a clear and substantial danger to the child's life or health ; or the child or his family is in need of treatment, rehabilitation or services not presently being received; AND the intervention of the court is essential to provide the treatment, rehabilitation or services needed by the child or his family.
- ❖ A Child in Need of Supervision means either:
 - A child who, while subject to compulsory school attendance, is habitually and without justification absent from school despite the school system's reasonable effort to effect the child's regular attendance without success and the school system files related documentation; (usually filed by truancy) or
 - A child who, without reasonable cause and without the consent of his parent, or guardian, remains away from or deserts or abandons his family/custodian on more than one occasion; or escapes or remains away from a court's residential placement AND such conduct presents a clear and substantial danger to to the child's life or health, the child or his family is in need of treatment, rehabilitation, or services not presently being received, and the intervention of the court is essential to provide the treatment, rehabilitation or services needed.
- ❖ A person who wants the court to consider a child as a Child In Need of Services or Supervision must file a petition with the Intake Officer of the Court Service Unit at the Juvenile and Domestic Relations courthouse at 909 Court St, Level B-1, Lynchburg between the hours of 8:30-11am and 1-2pm. The parent MUST bring the child with them to file, as the child and parent are both interviewed.
- ❖ After the petition is filed, the child and the parent(s) or guardian are notified to come to court so they can be told of the adjudicatory hearing (trial) date and time.
