Facts From The Game

Game details

- The game is a social commentary about how people will most likely take the easy and painful way to gain money.
- Harvey's original name was going to be Tyler, but this was changed because the name did not suit him. It can still be found in the files for his sprites!
- It is possible that we will get more in-depth lore on Harvey.
- The surgery the player needs is a reconstructive surgery.
- It is unanswered if Harvey knows what is sold in the shop and if he has any control over it.
- The creator was surprised people wanted a good ending.
- There is no information about why Harvey took so long to do anything when the player began to hurt him.
- The amount of money needed for each item and how much they give you in return is

 - Needle costs \$500 gives you \$4 (he has minor cuts)
 - Hammer costs \$1,500 gives you \$8 (you knock off some teeth) (you can still get the good ending up to this point)
 - Scissors costs \$3,000 gives you \$16 (you got his eye, slashed his other eye, his skirt is slightly opened) (you start getting the normal ending from here on out)
 - Match costs \$6,000 gives you \$32 (his eye is fully gone by now, he's got burns, his shirt is fully open to reveal more burns)
 - Knife costs \$10,000 gives you \$64
 - Gun costs \$20,000 Harvey will hand you \$99,999 in an attempt to make you leave him alone. (Bad ending jumpscare with Harvey's remains)
- In the normal ending, you are given a life sentence and are also forced to pay for decades of psychotherapy for Harvey, which he will need for the rest of his life.
- In the game files, Harvey's sprites are named Tyler. This was because his name was
 originally going to be Tyler, but was changed by the creator due to the name not suiting
 his overall appearance.

"What-if" scenarios

- He did not have a chance when he tried turning the tables on us, but if he was able to pull the player into the game, he would've killed them with the knife.
- If the player would've hugged Harvey in the good ending, his response would've been "OH hey, you're quite eager aren't ya? Glad I could help out! I do hope your life changes for the best and you always have a smile on your face!"
- Normal ending Harvey would either send a hitman after you or killed you himself if you did not end up with a life sentence.

Fun facts about the sequel to Bloodmoney! Not a single fact here is fun.

- The beginning shows a conversation between Eun-Mi and Harvey, it's clear Harvey is hesitant to be placed in the game, but hesitantly agrees to be in Eun-Mi's simulation.
- In the simulation, you are in charge of keeping Harvey fed and his mood up.
- The amount of food points you get per food and how much they cost:
 - Candy (\$1,000, 5pts)
 - o Bread (\$2,000, 10pts)
 - Donut (\$5,000, 20pts)
 - Pie (\$7,500, 40pts)
 - Cake (\$10,000, 60pts)
 - Big Salad (\$15,000, 80pts)
- The multiple endings in game are:
 - True Ending: You achieve this ending through playing the game normally. Feeding Harvey, keeping up with his mood, and letting the days pass. It ends after Harvey confronts Eun-Mi and deleting himself from her computer files, players who were playing Bloodmoney! discover what Eun-Mi was doing to Harvey and resorted to doxxing her. Eun-Mi's plans have failed and she is left to pick up the pieces.
 - Dead Ending: you achieve this ending through not feeding Harvey for a couple of days. You will be met with an image of Harvey's lifeless corpse, covered in maggots.
- Here are the games you can play with Harvey and how much they cost:
 - Whack-A-Harvey (\$2,500)
 - Memory Match (\$7,500)
 - Batting Cages (\$10,000)
 - Heavy Lifting (\$15,000)
 - Save Harvey (Free, though, it would take \$1 each time I played)

Easter Eggs and Details

- Phrases said if you overfeed Harvey:
 - "Babe, I'm already full. But... I guess one more wouldn't hurt."
 - o "A-another? Honey... I don't think I can..."

- There is a scarf on the shelf behind Harvey, a reference to manlybadasshero.
- There is an image of an Emu saved in the files. This is a small reference to Eun-Mi's name being mispronounced as such.
- All voice actors saying "A five Michelin Star establishment, which means it is very good".
 Presumably just testing out the microphone and/or voices. Could also be for the lulz.
- Secret Audio Recording from Harvey: "If you're listening to this, I'm already dead. Eun-Mi

As the title suggests, facts strictly about Toby Harvington.


- He is voiced by JCGonzo
