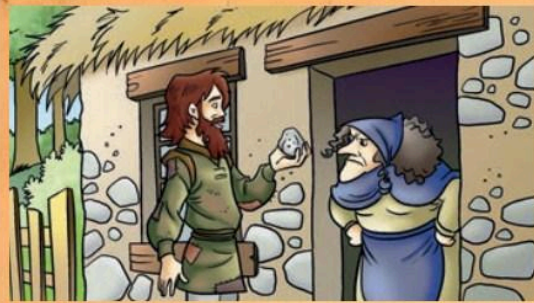


MOCK TEST – PROJECT 2 (UNIT 4)
