His father Tom Walton, was a farmer, but went to work in the farm mortgage business when the Great Depression hit. His parents' names are Tom Walton and Nancy Walton. Also, had one sibling named James. His nickname when he was born was Bud, AWWW SO ADORABLE. Sam grew up in Missouri with his younger brother James. Sam was a poor kid in the heartland of America during the time of The Great Depression. Sam went to Hickman High School. Also he went to two Colleges, one of is University of Missouri and the other one is College of Business. Sam Walton worked at a JC Penney's when he was in college, which is another well known super store. Then he graduated college with a degree in economics. Wal-Mart was a success that Sam Walton continued opening more of them. He joined the army in 1942 during world war 2.
